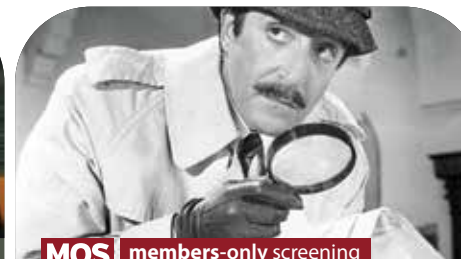

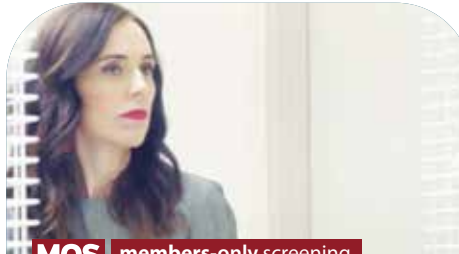

An intimate documentary blending personal footage and major events, offering a rare, human portrait of leadership beyond politics and public perception.



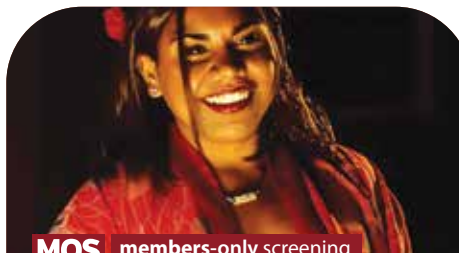
My Brother's Band

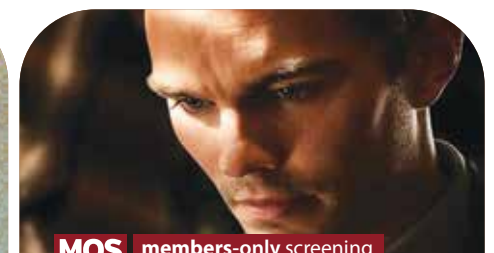
Radiance
